

**RESOLUTION OF
PEREGRINE MASTER ASSOCIATION, INC.
ADOPTING A COMMITTEE COMMUNICATION POLICY**

SUBJECT: Adoption of a policy and procedures for committees and how they communicate with homeowners.

PURPOSE: To provide a policy to structure how committees contact homeowners.

AUTHORITY: The Declaration, Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Association, and Colorado law.

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 30, 2014

RESOLUTION: The Association hereby adopts the following procedures regarding how committees communicate with homeowners.

1. **Committee Communications with Homeowners:** All communications from committees, including but not limited to Block Captain Officers, Block Captains, Architectural Review Committee and Social Media Committee members must be pre-approved in writing by the Board of Directors of Peregrine Master Association, Inc. (“Association”) prior to distribution to any homeowners within the Association.
2. **Prohibited Communications:** Communications from committees containing the following are prohibited:
 - Vulgar language;
 - Inappropriate images;
 - Personal attacks of any kind against any person, the Association or Board of Directors;
 - Advocating illegal activity;
 - Promotes services, products or political organizations;
 - Infringements on copyrights or trademarks;
 - Personally identifiable medical information;
 - Pictures not previously approved by the Board of Directors; and;
 - Information that may compromise the safety, security or proceedings of any legal action pertaining to the Association.
3. **Content Management:** The Board of Directors reserves the right to deny distribution of any communications from committees that they, in their sole discretion, deem inappropriate or harmful to the Association or any individual.
4. **Violation of Policy:** The committee member or members in violation of this Policy shall be subject to appropriate enforcement action in accordance with the Association’s Enforcement Policy, which may include fines (after notice and opportunity for hearing) or legal action.


5. Disclosure of Email Addresses: Committees shall not distribute email addresses to homeowners unless the Owner specifically authorizes the disclosure of such email.
6. Definitions. Unless otherwise defined in this Resolution, initially capitalized or terms defined in the Declaration shall have the same meaning herein.
7. Supplement to Law. The provisions of this Resolution shall be in addition to and in supplement of the terms and provisions of the Protective Covenants of Peregrine and the laws of the State of Colorado governing Peregrine Master Association, Inc.
8. Amendment. This Policy may be amended at any time by the Board of Directors.
